is planned in connection with the 21st annual conference of the *European Chapter on Combinatorial Optimization* (ECCO XXI, May 29-31, 2008, Dubrovnik, Croatia)

Contributions are not restricted to works that were presented at ECCO XXI, and submissions are invited from the entire ECCO community.

Articles on any theoretical or practical aspect of combinatorial optimization issues in scheduling are welcome.

#### **Submissions:**

Papers should be submitted electronically via the *Journal of Scheduling* online submission system <http://josh.edmgr.com/>, following the journal's instructions to authors. Please indicate that your submission is to the Special Issue on "**Combinatorial Optimization Issues in Scheduling**".

The submitted papers must be original, not previously published or currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. All papers submitted to the special issue will be reviewed in accordance with the standard procedures of the Journal of Scheduling.

To ensure the timely completion of the special issue, only papers on complete and mature studies requiring limited revision will be accepted. Authors of papers requiring major revision will be advised to re-submit them as regular contributions to the journal.
